## **Application for Waiver of Training Fee**

## **Training Fee Waiver**

Up to 40 waivers for the \$100 training fee will be provided in an effort to reduce financial barriers to participation for faith-based and nonprofit organizations. Individual organizations may request up to two (2) fee waivers.

## **Eligibility**

Faith-based and nonprofit organizations must certify in writing that they meet **one or more** of the following criteria:

- Currently providing programs or services to children and youth ages 10 to 18.
  If so, briefly describe the type(s) of programs and/or services offered, how long your organization has been delivering these programs and/or services, and the age and sex of youth who are eligible to participate.
- 2. Plan to provide programming and/or services to justice-involved children and youth within the next year. If so, briefly describe the type(s) of programs and/or services your organization would like to provide that have the potential to reduce future delinquency. Describe the youth population (i.e., age and sex) that your program will target.
- 3. Provide a letter from a county youth court judge or referee who currently refers or intends to make referrals to your organization.
- 4. Provide a letter from a middle or high school principal who currently collaborates or intends to collaborate with your organization to develop and implement school-based programs and services that reduce school referrals to the juvenile justice system for truancy and behavioral problems at school.

Applications for waiver of training fees should be submitted in the form of a letter addressed to Angela A. Robertson, Ph.D., Project Director of the Mississippi Juvenile Justice System Reform and Reinvestment Initiative.
